The Strategic Goods Commission has decided (Decision no. 11.2-2/126) to approve the application submitted by ArmNord OÜ (reg. no. 1206234) for the amendment of the data of military goods broker registration no. 11.2-7.16/8. Consequently, ArmNord OÜ was entered on 30 March 2026 into the national register of military goods brokers (registration entry EE/25/MLREG005-1) under the following conditions:

1) Goods subject to brokering – categories of the Military List: ML1, ML2, ML3, ML4, ML5, ML6, ML8, ML9, ML10, ML11, ML13, ML14, ML15, ML17, ML21.

2) Countries of origin and final destination of the brokering transaction: Algeria, Austria, Azerbaijan, Belgium, Bulgaria, Burkina Faso, Canada, China, Congo, Côte d'Ivoire, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Egypt, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, India, Indonesia, Iraq, Ireland, Italy, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Lithuania, Mali, Mauritania, Netherlands, Nigeria, Norway, Pakistan, Peru, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Turkey, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States, Uzbekistan, Vietnam.

3) The registration of the military goods broker no. EE/25/MLREG005-1 is valid until 7 September 2026.

The brokering of military goods shall be carried out in accordance with §§ 49–58 of the Strategic Goods Act (adopted on 7 December 2011, entered into force on 1 January 2012). A license must be applied for and obtained from the Strategic Goods Commission for each brokering transaction before carrying out the transaction. Pursuant to the International Sanctions Act (RT I 2010, 26, 129), brokering services may not be provided to countries for which relevant restrictions have been established.

A registered broker of military goods is obliged, pursuant to § 58 of the Strategic Goods Act, to submit a written report to the Commission on their activities. The report shall be prepared for each half-year, as at 30 June and 31 December, and shall be submitted within 30 calendar days from the end of the reporting period.

If ArmNord OÜ wishes to continue operating as a broker of military goods after the expiry of the registration period, a new application for registration as a military goods broker must be submitted to the Commission in advance.
